



- Facilitate communication & measurement
- The market is no longer the most efficient means of co-ordination
- Economic theory transaction cost theory, agency theory and convention theory






### Role in the economy



- By improving information transfers, standardization constitutes an original coordination mechanism for business relationships
- It assists in coordinating contractual relations with customers and shareholders.
- Standards reinforce the coordination process encourage trust among economic agents.
- In a nutshell:
  - Business interaction
  - Legislative enabler for commercial transactions
  - Innovative products to market
  - Interoperability between new and existing products, services and processes

#### Why are they important?

- Integral part of professionalism
- Underpins the status, regard and esteem conferred upon them by society
- Their work is regarded as vital to society



#### Being a profession....

Occupation, practice, or vocation requiring mastery of a complex set of knowledge and skills through formal education and/or practical experience.
